For a student to be considered in subsequent years, the applicant must reapply. Scholarship recipients are encouraged to attend the annual SC APWA Conference awards ceremony to receive the award. REQUIREMENTS:

The recipient of this scholarship must:

- Be enrolled in a public works related program at an accredited private or public college or university,
- Qualify as a SC in-state resident, and
- Submit an essay about why they are interested in public works and how their major relates to public works. Essay should be no longer than 1,000 words
